

## Remote Cultural Trip to Tanzania

This amazing adventure will be lead by Steve Krenzen and his team of local friends. We will cover the Safari areas of Serengeti, Crater for our game-viewing, but the focus of this trip will be on the local people and their culture. We will become a part of the local culture and experience it rather than see from a distance.

### The daily plan:

**Day 1:** arrive in Aretha; time of arrival will depend on your international flight, overnight in Aretha

**Day 2:** Early morning departure from the Hotel and off we head to the Lake Natrona area. The drive is a long one, however the scenery you are about to see will last in your memory forever. Once we turn off the main road, we drive right through the Rift Valley which incorporates some of the most beautiful geography and scenery in all of Africa!

Arrive at Natrona where we will be met by my good friend Mario's, who is one of the village elders and Wiseman. Most of the people in the area are of the Misaim Tribe. Overnight camping

**Day 3:** Explore the area on foot or in the vehicle, the choice is yours. If you have the desire and stamina, you can climb the active Volcanic Mountain, Loony Lanai. This is the holy mountain of the Misaim and has been used for all different types of ceremony and celebrations of the Misaim tradition. In the late afternoon we will all go to the waterfall for a relaxing swim and sun downer drinks.

Overnight camping

**Day 4:** More detailed exploring of the area and some real cultural teachings by Marios and his friends. You will have to experience this first hand!

**Day 5:** We will have to say goodbye to our new friends as we head out of Natron towards to Loliondoi area which is not too far away from Natron. This area is located on the back side of the Ngorogoro Crater and is not often visited by the average tourist. This is a game area and we will be able to game-drive, but the real special part of this area is its remoteness and we have the ability to track game on foot.

Overnight at tented camp

**Day 6:** All day will be spent tracking game. This is a rare opportunity to do it via foot in Tanzania  
Overnight at tented camp

**Day 7:** We depart the Loliondo area heading for The Ngorogoro Crater. We will explore the floor of this famous wonderland in the Afternoon upon our arrival  
Overnight at Ngorongoro Tahi lodge

**Day 8 and 9:** Today we get an early start as we head to the Serengeti National Park. Here we hope to see the mass migration of wildebeest and Zebra. When you have all of these animals moving, you will certainly have all of the world famous predators following.  
Camping Serengeti

**Day 10:** As depart the Serengeti, we head to the Tarangire area which is back in the direction of Arusha. We will spend one night at a brand new luxury lodge with one of the most beautiful settings in all of Africa. It is called Boundary Hill at is in the Lolkisale Conservation area. This is a private concession run by two brothers and the local community. It is about 75000 hectares in size.  
Overnight in 5 star luxury at Boundary Hill

**Day 11 and 12:** Travel a short distance and spend the next two nights at the village of Lolkisale. Again here we will become at part of the local culture by living at the village for two days rather than just passing through  
Overnight camping

**Day 13:** Our drive will take us through some amazing farmlands and tea fields on our way back to Arusha. Spend the afternoon shopping and exploring Arusha  
Evening flight home day rooms are available.

**Price:** \$4288 ground only, all transfers and meals while on the trip.  
Excluded: all international air, visas, items of personal nature, meals in Arusha, Zanzibar extension not included

**Note: The Tanzania portion will run back to back with the Sahara/Mali trip. This is not a tourist guaranteed departure, it is fully private!**

## **End of Trip**

**Day 14 and 15.** A beach break on the island of Zanzibar. Anyone from the group can add this on; all travellers going on to Mali will need to include these two days due to the flight schedules to Mali. Prices will vary depending on your choice of accommodation.
